## Celebrate

**Since our founding in 2004, we have:**

- Presented four spectacular Galas (2006 at Patchogue Theater, 2008 at Garden City Hotel, 2010 at Huntington's Oheka Castle and the 2012 at Huntington's Paramount Theater) at which we've inducted almost 100 individual musicians, groups, and music business entities from the worlds of rock 'n roll, hip-hop, classical, blues, metal, gospel, folk and jazz.
- Awarded thousands of dollars in scholarships to members of major Long Island-based youth orchestras.
- Introduced annual Music Educator of Note award for outstanding music teachers.
- Created professional seminars for working musicians, with panels of industry experts.
- Presented exhibitions and lectures about Long Island music history at area venues.

- Archive of historic sound recordings, film and video performances, including previously unavailable items.
- State-of-the-art media center, including classrooms and facilities for music creation
